**David Stanley Garland**, 87, of Crescent City, FL, died Tuesday, Nov. 20, 2012. David worked as a publicist for the U.S. Trotting Association and wrote articles for various newspapers and Hoof Beats. He came to live in Crescent City, FL from Michigan in the late 80s.

Hall of Fame horseman, Douglas J. Ackerman, 86, died May 28, in

North Carolina after an illness of almost two years.

According to Dean Hoffman, Doug was one of the most respected trainers in harness racing and widely admired for his innate horsemanship, ironclad integrity, and memorable sense of humor. His fellow horsemen held him in the highest esteem, and that is the ultimate

compliment in his profession. Mr. Ackerman was a fixture on the Grand Circuit for decades. CHHA Members from around the country knew and respected Doug.

James 'Jim' Carr passed away April 27. He was 70. Jim is a native of Hamilton, Ontario and made his living as a process server, delivering court documents. According to *Trot Insider*, His pacing colt, Big Jim, turned heads with his 1:51.1 win in the Dream Maker. Big Jim scored wins in the Breeders Crown and world record in the Governor's Cup. With every win, Carr would invite anyone interested out to the winner's circle to have their picture taken with his prized pacer. Carr could even lift kids up to pet the young stallion, and Big Jim would stand with perfect manners.



**Oreste S. DiDonato**, 89, of Brighton Heights, PA died May 23. He is Chaplain Joe Didonato's dad. Oreste was a postal clerk for 42 years, World War II Army veteran and Purple Heart recipient. Pastor Joe presided over his dad's funeral.

**Daniel R. Gernatt Sr.** who operated Dan Gernatt Farms in New York for many years and stood Sir Taurus at stud, died May 5 in his home after a brief illness. He was 97.

N.J., resident, died May 11. Her son, Peter J. Koch, is race secretary at
the Medowlands. Elizabeth was born in Brooklyn, N.Y.

Michigan Hall of Fame horseman **Ron Wrenn** died May 10. He was 62. Mr. Ron was a member of one

of Michigan's founding families of harness racing, following in the footsteps of his late father, Howard. "He was my role model and my mentor," said Ronnie Wrenn Jr. "We talked every day and we had a bond, especially over the last five years as I began driving. He had a passion for horse racing and I developed the same because of him." "He taught me to enjoy the simple things in life, how to always smile and never to judge," said Mr. Wrenn's daughter, Sandy, who is engaged to be married to horseman Trace Tetrick, "and for that I will always be thankful. I will carry him in my heart forever."
